6th Annual Stop-Drop-n-Roll Chili Cook-Off

Every year, Bass Pro partners with the WPIFF to present a CASI-sanctioned chili cook-off. All proceeds go to the WPIFF, a non-profit organization that has provided over \$779,000 in grants to injured firefighters, families of fallen firefighters, and fire departments.

Up to 100 chili teams enter the Stop-Drop-n-Roll Chili Cook-Off Competition. Each chili team is competing for prizes. But who decides who wins? You do!

What does it mean to be a chili judge?

As a chili judge, you cast an anonymous vote for your favorite chili. Here's how it works.

- » Each chili is tasted and scored on a scale of one to ten, with "ten" being the best and "one" being the worst.
- » Chili is judged in three-to-four rounds with different judges each time. Don't worry: you will **not** be sampling more than just a bite of the ten-to-twenty chilis. This is supposed to be fun, remember?
- » The first round of judging begins at 2:00 pm. Judges should arrive at the Chili Judge Booth 30 minutes prior to judging time.
