Vendor Guidelines

Vendors at the Stop-Drop-n-Roll are subject to the following stipulations.

- » Vendor spaces will be for informational purposes, sales of products, or free giveaways. You may use games and other promotional marketing tools. **No** beverage sales or coolers are allowed. You may purchase ice on site for \$3.00 a bag.
- » Standard spaces will be 10' x 10'. If you have a vendor trailer, vehicle, cart, etc. please provide dimensions. Extra charges for space may apply.
- » Vendor spaces are reserved when payment for the booth is received.
- » You should plan to arrive between 7 - 8 am on the morning of the cook-off. Please bring everything that you will need with you to minimize in-and-out-of-gate traffic, including tables, chairs, tent, and weights to secure the tent, as we will not provide these items.
- » Set up all booths and remove all vehicles from the fenced-in area no later than 9 am on the day of the event. There are no cars allowed on site after 9 am on Saturday. **No exceptions.**
- » You will receive a vendor receipt that will serve as your credentials.
- » We strongly encourage space decoration and artistic presentation.
- » **Important:** You will be responsible for collecting and managing your own cash system, posting prices, and paying taxes.
- » You will be responsible for cleaning up your booth during the event and before departure. You must remove all items from the festival site the evening of October 16, 2010.
- » The event will take place rain or shine. All vendor fees are final, and must be paid before booth setup.
